

Sitrep: Second Spill of Flood Situation in Bihar

21st August 2016

A. SITUATION REPORT

Bihar is facing second spill of flood situation after Ganga water crosses danger level. Districts adjoining Ganga are getting swamped and having population badly affected by the current of water moving in the houses.

As per CWC Report, Water Level of Ganga at Patna Gandhighat crossed danger level and reached 50.43 Meters which has also crossed the previous highest flood level recorded which was 50.27 Meter during 1994.

Information on Flood Situation from IAG Bihar Member NGOs;

- In Samastipur District, Mohiuddinnagar and Mohanpur blocks of Patori sub division are getting flood affected. Water may get overtopped in these areas if Ganga continues growing.
- People who are inside the embankments near Patna town have started leaving their houses.
- Embankment near Hetanpur/Rasalpur in Mohanpur Block damaged around 20 ft wide.
- Hathitola, Islamganj Tola, Muji Tola, Dudhaila, Bintoli, Haldi Chapra, Dhajwa Tola, Purana Tola, Saatana, Badaltola, Naika Tola, Chamtoli, Ramnagar, are badly affected near Maner.
- 4 Houses destroyed in Adalchak Dumaria, 2 houses destroyed in rambad and 07 houses damaged in Jangalia Tola as per eyewitness of IAG members.

C. RESPONSE BY GOVERNMENT AND HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES

Government Response:

- Search & Rescue operation is going on by district administration with the help of NDRF and SDRF.
- Bihar SDRF teams have evacuated people to safer locations like school, community halls etc.
- 05 relief camps are going on by District Administration in Barhara and Koilwar Block of Bhojpur.
- Bihar Voluntary Health Association has started hosting displaced people in their office premises in Patna.
- Action Aid and Dalit Adhikar Manch are carrying out primary assessment in Maner Block of Patna District.
- IAG Bihar is closely monitoring the situation in high alert districts.

D. EMERGING NEEDS:

- **Drinking Water**
- **Cooked Food** (Food is being provided by District Authority but there is a more need for cooked food currently)
- **Food for Children**
- **Tarpaulin**
- **Hygiene Kits**
