

Sitrep-1: Earthquake in Tripura, India 3rd January, 2017

A. SITUATION REPORT

An earthquake of magnitude 5.7 on Richter scale hit Tripura on Tuesday afternoon. The epicentre of the earthquake was reported to be in Dhalai district of Tripura. Mild tremors were felt across northeast India.

No casualties and damages have been reported so far except crack on mud wall of the houses in few villages in Dhalai district.
