



Situation Report -1:
Floods and Landslides in North East India
16th June, 2017

A. Situation Report

Heavy rainfall triggered by flash floods and landslides has caused massive damage to life and property in Mizoram. Power supply lines have snapped and telecommunication network remained disrupted in the state capital due to landslides and heavy downpour. Many were left homeless and number of missing peoples are likely to increase in coming days.

Meanwhile, breaches of embankment in many places along river banks due to raising river water level followed by heavy rainfall and water logging of low-lying areas in Imphal valley were reported.

B. Impacts

Mizoram:

- **Aizawl :** 50 buildings damaged by landslides, affecting 100 families.
- **Lunglei district:** Nearly 2,000 families were estimated to be affected by landslides.

C. Humanitarian Response:

Government Response:

- The floods and landslides affected communities were evacuated to safer places.
- Foods items were distributed at relief camps in Lunglei district by respective MLAs and Districts Authorities.
- SDRF personal were deployed in affected districts for search and rescue works.

Humanitarians Response:

- Sphere India is collaboration with Inter Agency Groups is closely monitoring the situation.

D. Emerging Needs

- Shelter and Household items (Tarpaulin sheets, Floor mates, Kitchen Utensils, Emergency Solar Lamps, Hygiene kits and Dignity Kits)
- Bleaching powders and water purification tablets
- Foods
- Trauma counseling/ psychological support (medicines and Doctors)
- Temporary Toilets.
