

**The 2<sup>nd</sup>**  
**Inter-Agencies Group (IAG) Manipur Meeting**

**Date** : 26<sup>th</sup> June 2018  
**Venue** : DSSS, Imphal

**Minutes:**

The second IAG meeting was held on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2018 at DSSS, Imphal. A total of 9 (nine) representatives from five member organisations attended the meeting.

Rev. Fr. Anthony Avince Dilbung, Convener IAG and Director DSSS, Imphal welcomed the participants and shared immense gratitude for attending the meeting in spite of meeting circulation in a short period of time. He also briefed on work distribution among the member groups to avoid duplicacy of work in the intervention process.

Rev. Fr. Mung, Asst. Director DSSS, Imphal shared the discussion points of the previous meeting which includes:

3. Operational areas
4. Rapid Assessment in various flood affected areas

The meeting session was followed by sharing of initiatives taken by each groups in response of the flood affected blocks/villages.

**CASA:** Representative of CASA, Awon Munvung shared that, the organisation will reach out to different flood affected areas of Imphal East and Imphal West Districts where no other IAG member organisations have intervened which includes: New Checkon, Chasat Avenue, Tribal colony, Tarung, Langol etc.

New Life Foundation, an IAG member Organisation assured to intervene and respond to the needs (disaster) collaborating with different partners in the future. The member organisation was also advised to maintain the assessment report of disaster for future references.

As reported by Fr. Mung, Asst. Director DSSS, Imphal, World Vision will reach out to 900 beneficiaries of Imphal West Districts viz: Iroisemba, Lamboi Khongnankhong, Lamboi Khongnankhong Maning and Mamang Leikai and Naremthong Khullen Leikai.

The present member organisations of IAG Manipur agreed upon sharing of disaster data during the time of needs for better implementation. It is also agreed that complete updated and completion of URS Matrix and submission will be on 29<sup>th</sup> June 2018.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from Fr. Mung, Asst. Director-DSSS, Imphal. He thanked the participants for sharing their learning experiences, targeted implementation areas and also look forward to continue cooperation in response to the disaster needs of the communities in the future.
